 - Psychology, etc.

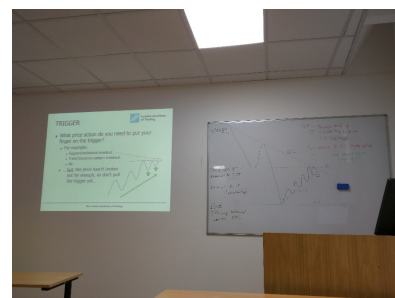
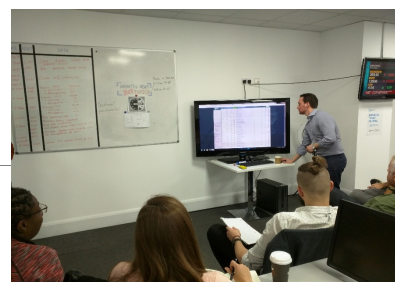

Did I enjoy my time? – YES

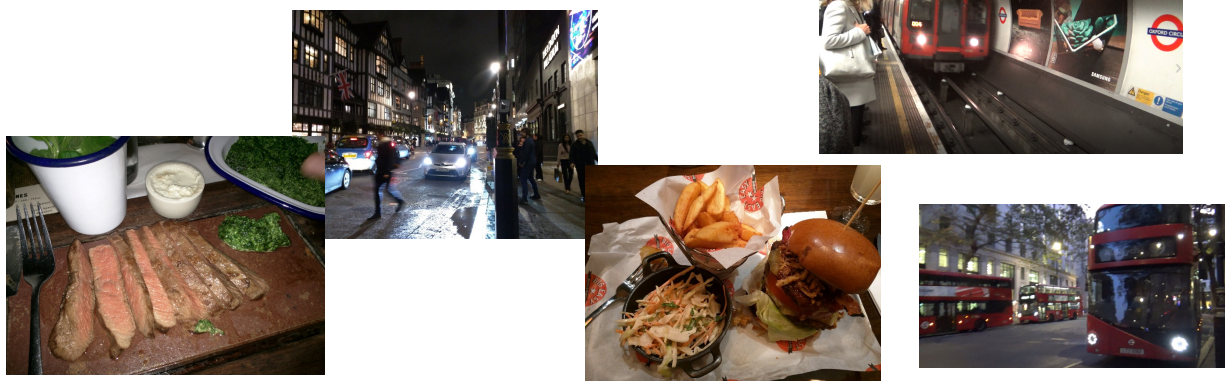
Was it hard? – YES
