Jishukan High School has been designated as SGH (Super Global High School). We have two sister schools in England and one in Germany, and we are expanding our partnership with the three schools into the project called "SGH Overseas Study Program." Now 43 students are trying to conduct their own research on Japanese culture and history from global perspectives. They will soon finish their research and will have a presentation session on December 19th.

We would like you to join our session and listen to their presentation. They are looking forward to being listened to, and being given questions and advices by as many people as possible. What is more, they will have discussion in English on a global, cultural topic.

We are looking for 20 English speakers who would be interested in helping our students. Additionally, we hope that it will be a good chance for all involved to have this fruitful, cross-cultural experience.

You must be from other countries than Japan and must speak English.

(You don't have to be a native speaker of English.)

■ Kind of activities:

In each small group including 2-3 of our students, you will first listen to presentation made by them. You can give questions and advices to them, but please make sure that this is not a training, but final presentation. After all the students' presentation finishes, you and they will discuss a global topic related to culture in English. One session will last for 55 minutes.

We will change the members and you will have 3 sessions in total. Finally, we would like you and our students to give the final idea and to share it with other groups in the room.

We predict that it will be a bit of a struggle for our students, but we believe that this kind of activity will be an effective and enjoyable way to get them interested in understanding culture of different countries. We would like to encourage all participants involved to make this event as interesting and exciting as possible!
