9. About Jishukan High School and “English Assembly II”:

Jishukan Senior High School has been designated as SGH (Super Global High School) by Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology since 2015. SGH focuses on social studies and aims to nurture global leaders. On the basis of this SGH designation, we have set up a program “SGH Overseas Study”. Through this program we are training the participants to be the future leaders who have global perspective and can challenge answerless problems using their intellect, flexible mind and communication skills.

In this SGH Overseas Study program, students conduct researches on Japanese culture and history. Now 44 students are participating in this project and finally 16 selected students are going to be sent to three countries abroad: England, Germany and Malaysia.

As the final training in Japan of the SGH Overseas Study program, we are planning to hold a special event “English Assembly II”. (English Assembly I is going to be held on 13<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> December in prior to this English Assembly II.) The purpose of this event is to motivate our students to be more interested in different cultures and to think more about the future relationship between Japan and other countries. In this event students speak only in English. The main activities of this event are poster presentation on their research and talking session.

We would like you to join the students' poster sessions and talking sessions. Our students are looking forward to being listened to, and being given questions and advice. We hope that it will be a good chance for all involved to have this fruitful, cross-cultural experience.
