Place: Jishukan High School (Tomimoto-cho, Toyohashi-city)

## **Eligibility**:

> You must be from another country and must speak English.

(You don't have to be a native speaker of English.)

#### ■ Activities:

- You will have short 10-minute conversations in a small group with our students (3-4 students in each group). After that, each of them make a presentation on a scientific topic for 10 minutes, including Q&A sessions. They have been working on their research based either on basic scientific experiments or on bibliographic survey. We would like you to give advices to them so that they will be able to improve their presentation skills for their future. After all the students finish their presentations, the members will switch. You have 10-minute break and the second session (group talk and presentations with different students) starts.
- We predict these sessions will be a bit of a struggle for our students, but we believe this kind of activity will be an effective and enjoyable way to get them excited about learning English and more motivated. In group talk, you can share your country, culture, language, history, personal belongings, hobbies, family, etc. We want to encourage all participants involved to make this as fun and exciting as possible!
