on Group Work Practice with High School Students in English

Jishukan High School is going to take part in a science conference held in London next March. 24 Japanese students from Aichi Prefecture, including some Jishukan High School students, will give English presentations about their scientific research results in the conference. The participants are expected to discuss the results with other participants in English. Furthermore, they will also participate in the experimental competition, in which they must cooperate with students from England and Germany, during their stay in London.

We are looking for English speakers who would be interested in helping our students use English as an effective tool for communication.

■ Time & Place:

■ Eligibility:

You must be from another country and must speak English. You don't have to be a native speaker of English.

■ Kind of activities:

You will make a group with two students. Then you will enjoy working on some chemical experiments with the same group members. In the experiments, we will expect our students to play active roles in several scenes such as making their course, leading the others and assisting them. So we will ask you just to take part in the work and to enjoy working in the group. If you think it is necessary, we would like you to give them some advices so that their performances will be better.

■ A monetary reward: *Bank account is necessary.

¥3,255 (daily payment) + ¥1,160 (transportation expenses) = ¥4,415

*If you participate both in the morning session and the afternoon one, the total amount of money we will pay is ¥8,321 (¥4,415 + ¥3,906).
