on High School Student's Presentation and Cultural Discussion in English

Jishukan High School has been designated as SGH (Super Global High School). We have four sister schools in England, Germany and Malaysia, and we are expanding our partnership with the three schools into the project called "Jishukan International Program." Now 46 students are trying to conduct their research on a problem in Japan from global perspectives. They will soon finish their research and will make a presentation on November 10th.

We would like you to join our session and listen to their poster presentation. They are looking forward to being listened to, and being given questions and advices by as many people as possible. What is more, they will have discussion in English on a global, cultural topic.

We are looking for 16 English speakers who would be interested in helping our students. Additionally, we hope that it will be a good chance for all involved to have this fruitful, cross-cultural experience.

Each of the four rounds may have as many posters as the participants from TUT. You will see two posters (one assigned, one favorite) in each round. You are kindly asked to listen to the presentations, give questions and advice to the speakers. Talking sessions will follow it and be done in small groups of four or five, including you. You do not have to prepare anything for the session in advance. Please just enjoy the session with our students!

- (2) On Tuesday, 15th October, we will send a reply to all the messages that we will have received by the previous day. We will attach an application form (Microsoft Excel Worksheet) on it. Please fill out the form based on the direction in the message, and then send it to us by the deadline.
- (3) After that, we will choose at most 16 participants, giving priority to (1) those who have ever participated in this kind of program (in which TUT students give comments on our students’ presentations or have an interaction in English with our students) in Jishukan High School and (2) those who will send the form earlier.
