

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Amano Institute of Technology Scholarship for 2020

1. PURPOSE

Toyohashi University of Technology (TUT) accepts applications from students for study in TUT who satisfy the following qualifications and conditions. Its aim is to support outstanding students (including enrolled students) enrolled in the doctoral course of the Graduate School of Engineering of TUT with the donation of Amano Institute of Technology until the completion of the doctoral course.

2. QUALIFICATIONS AND CONDITIONS

Applicants must fall under any of the following (1) to (4) and fall under (5) and (6) and have been recommended by their academic advisor, regardless of their nationality.

- (1) Those who entered a doctoral program in the Graduate School in April 2019 and are currently in the second grade
- (2) Those who entered a doctoral program in the Graduate School in October 2019 currently in the second grade
- (3) Those who entered a doctoral program in April 2020 and are currently in the first grade
- (4) Those who entered a doctoral program in October 2020 and are currently in the first grade
- (5) Those who fall under any of the above (1) to (4) and who intend to obtain a doctoral degree from TUT within the standard period of study.
- (6) Those who are healthy in mind and body, and excellent in academic achievements.

3. NUMBER OF STUDENTS TO WHOM THE SCHOLARSHIP IS AWARDED

First grade student: 4 students

Second grade student: 1 student

4. APPLICATIONS PROCEDURES

Applicants must submit the following documents to the International Affairs Division by the designated deadline.

- Application Form (Form 1)
- Letter of recommendation from TUT supervisor (Form 2)
- Research plan (Form 3)
- Certificate grade transcript for each academic year from the last university attended
- Documents to prove your language ability (English and Japanese)

5. THE PROCESS OF SELECTION

We will conduct the screening of applicants by means of submitted application documents.

6. SCHOLRSHIP BENEFITS

Allowance: 125,000 Japanese yen/month

*Travel expenses to come to Japan and return to applicant's own country, examination fee, admission fee and tuition are not granted.

*A grantee is not permitted to receive any other scholarship while he/she is receiving this scholarship.

7. PERIOD OF SCHOLARSHIP

Two (2) years or Three (3) years after grant decision up until completion of the doctoral program (standard period of study).

8. SUSPENSION OF PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Payment of the scholarship will be cancelled for the reasons given below. Should any of the following reasons apply, the recipient may be ordered to return a part of, or all of, the scholarship paid up to that time.

- (1) A grantee requests a leave of absence or withdrawal from TUT;
- (2) A grantee becomes subject to disciplinary action under Article 57 of the TUT Academic Regulations;
- (3) A grantee's research is completed, or is suspended or discontinued before the end of the scholarship period;
- (4) A grantee does not sign on a form of the monthly enrollment confirmation;
- (5) A grantee is absent from Japan for personal reasons and does not sign on a form of the monthly enrollment confirmation;

9. NOTES

The grantees must submit a research activity report to Amano Institute of Technology every year after the start of receiving the scholarship, and submit a research result report by the method designated by Amano Institute of Technology at the end of the receiving period.
